Located in beautiful Tatamagouche, this 10-bed community hospital provides a variety of services including:

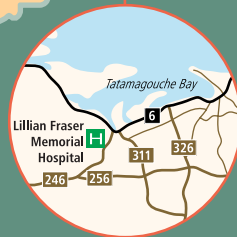
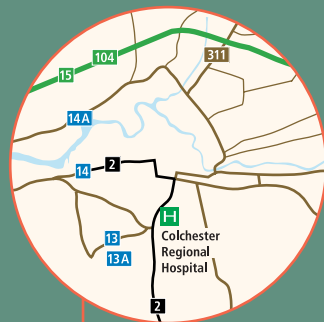
